What we once called UFOs, but □21 have been much in the news lately. The *Washington Post*, for example, ran an article in 2023 in which the author, Terrence McCoy, pointed out that in the United States, information about UAPs is often classified, while other countries such as Brazil and many other South American nations freely share information about UAPs.

Many of those who believe that UAPs are, in fact, alien spaceships seem to think that there is only one reason the US would keep the information they are assumed to have about UAPs secret: The government has proof that the UAPs are alien spaceships. McCoy never says that this is the case, but since he □22 his article could be used to support this position.

planes, satellites, drones, balloons, and other flying technology to keep an eye on both its own territory and that of other countries. It is highly likely that some of the UAPs people have seen over the years were actually this kind of military technology, which may explain why many UAP sightings occur near military bases. If many UAPs are in fact devices launched by the US military, it is not surprising that the military wants to keep information about them secret.

Countries that do not use this sort of technology to observe their territory and that of other countries would have less reason to keep information about UAPs secret. This may, in part, explain why such countries are so much more willing than the US to share the information they have about UAPs.

Further, since countries such as Brazil 24 UAPs, one would think that if these UAPs were, in fact, alien spacecraft, we would have seen solid evidence for that in the information they release. In fact, however, the information that governments such as Brazil's have made public is just as poor as all the other evidence we have that UAPs are aliens or alien spacecraft. The information, 25 that the Brazilian government has made available consists of the same poor-quality photographs and unreliable witness testimony that we have seen before.

We still don't have solid evidence that UAPs are alien spacecraft. The openness of governments like Brazil's hasn't changed this. There may be alien spacecraft out there, but there is no good evidence that they have visited us . . . yet.
